The Keystone Educational Endowment Program is pleased to announce the availability of several academic scholarships. Interested students are encouraged to apply for every KEEP scholarship for which he/she is qualified.

Please read the following requirements carefully and include all information requested. In addition to these general requirements, each scholarship has its own set of criteria that is outlined below.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- * You must be enrolled as a senior at Keystone High School or the Lorain County JVS with Keystone your home school.
- * Every application must include the **cover page with writing prompt, activities page**, and a copy of your **transcript**.
- * Return your completed application to the Keystone High School Guidance Office by the due date.

- * Your **STUDENT ID** must appear on the **top of every page**. **DO NOT** write your name.
- * **DO NOT** include a **letter of recommendation** unless the scholarship specifies it.
- * Submit all papers using a **PAPERCLIP**. **DO NOT STAPLE** papers.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS PER SCHOLARSHIP: * Use weighted GPA where applicable

Scholarship	Requirement(s)
KEEP Anonymous Scholarship	Must be pursuing an industrial/technical or business career.
KEEP Memorial Scholarship	Must be well rounded and community oriented; Minimum GPA of 3.5.
KEEP General Scholarship	Must be well rounded and community oriented.
Shirley Dombrosky Scholarship	Merit based, no specific major; Minimum GPA of 2.0.
Marge Fatz Scholarship	Community service involvement; Have field of study selected; Involvement with service clubs/organizations
Holcomb-Denham Scholarship	Pursuit of any type of further education except law; Well rounded and community oriented; Minimum GPA of 2.0
Krieder-Coleman Scholarship	Must be planning to attend an accredited school of Nursing pursuing RN or BS degree; High scholastic ability with at least a GPA of 3.0
Tony Prewitt Scholarship	Must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or BELOW and a desire to attend college.
Logan Stiner Scholarship	Minimum GPA of 4.0; Member of the National Honor Society; Strong work ethic.
Rosalind A. Voyner Scholarship	Must be actively involved in band during high school.
Scholarships <i>BELOW</i> require additional items	<i>*Place the extra items behind the general required items. Submit only 1 application with all required items paperclipped together.</i>
John R. Yates Scholarship	Must have outstanding academic success, community service and citizenship. Must submit a typed example of your writing. Add Student ID to top right.
Seth J. Sheldon Scholarship	Must exhibit school/community service and academic excellence. Must submit 1 teacher's recommendation and a short essay explaining why you wish to be awarded the scholarship. Add Student ID to top right of each.

I understand this is a one year scholarship and if for any reason, circumstances prevent my attendance at college as a full-time student or completion of my first year of college, the full amount awarded to me will be returned to KEEP by my college. This scholarship must be used within fifteen months following high school graduation.
