- * Every application must include the cover page with writing prompt, activities page, and a copy of your transcript.
- * Return your completed application to the Keystone High School Guidance Office by the due date.
- * Your **STUDENT ID** must appear on the **top of every page**. DO NOT write your name.
- * DO NOT include a letter of recommendation unless the scholarship specifies it.
- * Submit all papers using a PAPERCLIP. DO NOT STAPLE papers.
