Measurement of Academic Progress (MAP) Testing -

- 95%ile = Identification
- 90%ile 94%ile = Reassessment

Grade Two - Grade Ten

- Three opportunities Each Year
- Math, Reading
- Science

Cognitive Identification


- 85-115 = Average
- The Cognitive Abilities Test (CogAT)
- 128 = Identification
- 120 127 = Reassessment
- Creative Thinking Evaluation = 112

Two Opportunities

Grade Two & Grade Five

Creative Thinking -

- Scales for Rating the Behavioral Characteristics of Superior Students (SRBCCS / Renzulli)
- Teacher Checklist
- Identification = 51
- Further Evaluation = 48-50



Specific Academic -

- Iowa Test of Basic Skills (ITBS)
- 95%ile = Identification
- 90%ile 94%ile = Reassessment

Science, Social Studies

Iowa Algebra Aptitude Test

- 85%ile or above on a MAP score from Winter <u>or</u> Spring <u>AND</u>
- 85%ile or above on the IAAT

American College Test (ACT)

• 95%ile = Identification

- Visual Arts
- Music
- Drama
- Dance
