Per USDA guidelines, Keystone Local School District has elected to provide Lactaid, a nutritionally comparable milk substitute, to accommodate children with allergies or intolerances. This offering is made to students who have a documented allergy and who have submitted a physician's note to the school nurse or Food Services Supervisor.

Please note, we are no longer able to house milk substitutes brought from home in the cafeteria cooler.
