Dear Parents/Guardians and Students:

Due to a law enacted by our Ohio Legislature, Keystone High School will be offering the SAT to all members of the Class of 2025 FREE of charge. The SAT, Scholastic Assessment Test, consists of 52 reading questions, 35 writing and language questions and 80 math questions. Most of the questions are multiple choice with a few math questions that require the students to write in their answer.

Why take the SAT? Most colleges-including those that are test optional-still accept SAT test scores. Together with high school grades, the SAT can show a student's potential to succeed in college or a career. Taking the SAT is strong evidence that you're ready for college and have what a college is looking for. Plus, you can choose to send your best scores to colleges. The PSAT helps students prepare for the SAT. Historically, students who took the PSAT score higher on the SAT, on average, compared to those who don't take the PSAT. The PSAT and SAT will take place on Monday, March 4th and will last from 7:28 am until approximately 11:45 am. All juniors will be notified of their testing rooms via email and Google Classroom. Members of the junior class who are full-time CCP students or LCJVS students should also plan to take the SAT on this day.

All SAT pre-registration will be completed online. Information and instructions for completion of registration will be posted on the Class of 2025's Google Classroom. Please contact the front office to verify that your registration has been completed or to ask any questions.

If you are a LCJVS freshman, sophomore, or senior, you will have a normal school day at the JVS. If you are a JUNIOR who attends the LCJVS, you will still take the SAT on March 4th at KHS. You are not required to return to JVS later that day, as the JVS will not have school for juniors on SAT testing day.

Freshman, sophomore, and senior students that attend KHS will have several options to choose from on that day.



Freshmen-Select One:
I will attend school that day and utilize the opportunity to listen to guest speakers talk
about their careers.
I will schedule a college visit, or I have made arrangements for job-shadowing for the day.
Sophomores-Select One:
I signed up for the PSAT and will stay to listen to guest speakers talk about their careers.
I signed up for the PSAT and will leave after testing to attend a college visit, or I have
made arrangements for job-shadowing for the remainder of the school day.
I will attend school that day and utilize the opportunity to listen to guest speakers talk about their careers.

Juniors-Select One: I must take the SAT and will stay for the guest speaker portion of the day after testing. I must take the SAT, and I will leave after testing to attend a college visit, or I have made arrangements for job-shadowing for the remainder of the school day.
Seniors-Select One:
I will attend school that day and utilize the opportunity to listen to guest speakers talk about their careers.
I will attend a college visit, or I have made arrangements for job-shadowing for the day.
